ARIZONA — If there are items in your house or garage collecting dust, and they are not the duster, it's time to donate those items to St. Vincent de Paul. Donated items are given directly to the poor or sold in our thrift stores.

St. Vincent de Paul operates eight thrift stores throughout the Valley, where people in need — and the general public — can shop for low-cost clothing, furniture and household items. The stores also operate as neighborhood distribution centers, where the people we serve can receive much needed items free of charge. The funds from the stores help support our programs and services for the hungry, homeless and working poor.

We accept gently used furniture, appliances, clothing and household items including beds, cribs, kitchen tables and chairs, working refrigerators, washers and dryers, stoves, dressers, linens, lamps, flatware, pots and pans, dishware and tools.

Donations may be dropped off at all of our store locations (see below) and a tax receipt will be provided. Also, St. Vincent de Paul trucks pick-up donations throughout greater Phoenix, including Anthem, Queen Creek, Maricopa and Buckeye areas.
