Celebrate Easter with the Society of St. Vincent de Paul

St. Vincent de Paul will celebrate special traditions throughout the week leading up to Easter. On Tuesday, April 3rd, and Wednesday, April 4th, the Society will dye more than 100 eggs with children who dine at the Family Evening Meal. The eggs are part of 4,000 dozen donated by Hickman Family Farms to feed the hungry in our five Valley dining rooms and pass out in food boxes to needy families.

After dinner the following day, children will receive an Easter basket and visit with the Easter bunny. Every year, this annual party shares Easter traditions with children who might not otherwise have the experience with their families.
