Kino Border Initiative (KBI) is a bi-national mission to deportees in Nogales, Sonora. The KBI is jointly sponsored by the Society of Jesus, California Province and Society of Jesus, Mexico, the Archdiocese of Hermasillo, the Roman Catholic Diocese of Tucson and Missionary Sisters of the Eucharist. Women and children are frequently deported at Nogales by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE). The KBI is currently providing meals for up to 200 persons daily and runs a small shelter for women and children. In addition to its humanitarian role, the KBI is collecting data and providing education about immigration along the U.S. Mexican border.
