World's fastest omelet maker to serve at St. Vincent de Paul

Hickman's set to help prepare 500 omelets for dinner

PHOENIX — Washing the dishes might take longer than cooking dinner on Thursday night at St. Vincent de Paul.

Hickman's Family Farms is flying Howard Helmer, the world's fastest omelet maker, from New York to Phoenix to serve breakfast for dinner on Thursday, Dec. 11, at St. Vincent de Paul, 420 W. Watkins Road. Helmer is a two-time Guinness world record holder, and can turn out 427 omelets in 30 minutes.

On this night, local food providers Hickman's, Shamrock Farms, Bar-S, and Holsum Bread are providing all of the food and joining together to aid Helmer when they prepare 500 omelets for the Valley's homeless and working poor families.

Roxie the Cow and the Funky Chicken also will be handing out kids games and serving in the dining room during the event.
