The 8,200 square-foot facility is packed with low-cost clothes, furniture, household items and hundreds of hidden treasures. It is open Monday through Saturday from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. and on Sundays from 11 a.m. to 4p.m.

The Society of St. Vincent de Paul operates a total of 16 thrift stores throughout central and northern Arizona, where people in need - and the general public - can affordable items. The stores also operate as neighborhood distribution centers, where the people we serve can receive much needed items free of charge. Donations are accepted at all of our stores. Our store sales help fund the programs and services we provide to the homeless and working poor.
